<ul> <li>Cement floors with raised sides, which are cleaned and disinfected after EVERY flock, then vacant for 2-3 weeks to break any virus or bacteria life cycle.</li> </ul>	ď	
<ul> <li>No partial house brooding means chicks have full access to the barn from Day 1 and are not stressed by being forced to move to a different location as they grow.</li> </ul>	ď	
<ul> <li>Natural light through plentiful windows and doors.</li> </ul>	V

Feed and Water		
<ul> <li>Access for all chickens to fresh water and a diet designed to maintain full health, and promote positive well-being.</li> </ul>	<b>₹</b>	<b>✓</b>
<ul> <li>Fed a diet of corn and extruded &amp; expeller-pressed soybeans. No hexane, No DDGS or ethanol by-products (which are known to contain antibiotics) or No animal by-products.</li> </ul>	v

<ul> <li>Essential oils and spices, such as Oregano oil, Cinnamon and Yucca, to promote gut health.</li> </ul>	<b>₹</b>	
Transportation and Processing		
<ul> <li>Chickens placed in open drawers on the farm and remain there until after Slow Induction Anesthesia (SIA) – No Dump System.</li> </ul>	<b>✓</b>	
<ul> <li>On average, our chickens have LESS THAN ONE HOUR of transportation time from farm to facility.</li> </ul>	<b>✓</b>	
<ul> <li>Loaded live-haul trailers are stationed in the CALMING BARN to reduce stress caused by transportation.</li> </ul>	ď	
<ul> <li>SLOW INDUCTION ANESTHESIA (SIA): Birds are slowly rendered unconscious prior to the start of processing.</li> </ul>	ď	
<ul> <li>Live haul trailers and drawers cleaned and disinfected after every use.</li> </ul>	<b>√</b>
